MICHAEL SCOTT

After being awarded the Premier Prix de Flute at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique, Paris, Michael began a 30 year career as a Principal in major Australian orchestras. Concurrently, he spent 25 years in senior academic positions within the Universities of Sydney and Adelaide. He also possesses extensive skills as a music educator of school students, having prepared and delivered workshops / seminars to over 300 pre-school, primary and high school students. Michael was recently appointed to the position of Project Manager, Conservatorium Mid North Coast.
